Wm. M. Travis & Co.

Whereas William M. Travis & John M. Davis jr, purchased the lot of land
whereon is located the store house in the village of Washburn (said house
known as the Barron Store house from Maryus Jones, S. J. Jones and J.
W. Stubbs who were appointed Special commissioners of the Circuit
Court of Barron County, in the County of Barron Wisconsin under
the style of Barron vs Stubbs, for the sum of one thousand seven
hundred and ten dollars, and whereas the said title of the said land was
conferred to the said Travis and said Davis jr, and whereas John W. Davis jr
to be named in Co purchase, or any - for and receipt of the original
"Barron Store house lot" and whereas the said William M. Travis
and John M. Davis jr have paid the whole of the said purchase
money to Maryus Jones, who was appointed and qualified as a
Special commissioner to collect the same and who has reported the same
to the Court for distribution. Now know for this deed made and entered
into this 28th day of March 1893, before Maryus Jones Special Com-
missioner as aforesaid, partly of the first part by William M. Travis
and John M. Davis jr, partly of the second part, the said conveyance
to the said Davis jr, at the request of said Travis & Davis jr,
that for and in consideration of the premises and of the here-
unto the sum of money as above recited and said title of the first part
said said land, sold and granted, and by these presents doth, bargain

sell grant and convey with special warranty in law unto the said parties
of the second part all that certain tract or parcel of land above described
lying in the village of Matthews Court House, and bounded by the street
which runs between the Barnum Stone lot and the Davis Hotel, by the
street to the east of the Davis Hotel, by the lands of Charles Amistead and
by the lot purchased by William M. Miller, under decree in the said chan-
cery cause, to have and to hold unto them the said William M. Miller &
John W. Brown Jr. their heirs and assigns forever.
